#### **ENTRY LIMITATIONS**

Each participant can play a maximum of two (2) classes beginning on Saturday. Players entering B/G 13 **can't** enter JB/JG 18 or JB/JG 23. Players entering B/G 12 **can't** enter B/G 16. Women/Girls can't enter in Men/Boys classes.







### SEEDING

All classes are seeding according to the Swedish TTA rules.

The official Swedish computer ranking will be used for both Swedish players and international players with a Swedish ranking.

International players without a Swedish ranking may be seeded, after consideration by the tournament organization including the competition manager. In this case the seeding will be reviewed by the Swedish TTA.

#### **PRIZE MONEY**

Sweden Tour uses the policy of equal prize money for men and women. A total of SEK 40,000 will be awarded in the Elite events and SEK 36,000 in 23, 20 and 18 events.

Prize money for the Elite events may be reduced in case of low participation. Prize money will be paid to the preferred bank account. Any applicable tax will be paid by the player.
